### Entries

Entries and payments must be completed online: [www.colonialclassichorseshow.com](http://www.colonialclassichorseshow.com) and are due by August 10, 2014. No Post Entries accepted. No Phone or Fax entries accepted. If we do not receive an entry and payment by August 10, we will notify the next qualified rider. No refunds without a veterinarian note. Entry Fee: \$150/division \*does not include stabling. Requirement: Valid Coggins test for PA residents, Valid Coggins and Health Certificate for out-of-state residents must be presented before a back number will be issued.

### Scratches

Scratches are accepted before August 10, 2014.

### Schooling and Arrival Rules

Per grounds rules, there will be NO SCHOOLING over jumps the morning of August 24, 2014. We strongly encourage everyone to take advantage of the Harrisburg Horse Show on Saturday, August 23, 2014. Please use this show as your schooling for the Colonial Classic. All Colonial Classic participants that are not entered in the Harrisburg Horse Show are not permitted in any of the schooling areas until the Harrisburg Horse Show has concluded. Colonial Classic exhibitors who have purchased stabling for Saturday night may arrive after 12:00 noon on Saturday.

**Saturday Equine Arena schooling:** At the conclusion of the Harrisburg Horse Show there will be controlled schooling in the show ring in the Equine Arena. NOTE: Riders may not use the schooling area in the Equine Arena or the outdoor warm up ring until the conclusion of classes in the Large Arena. These schooling areas are for riders in the USHJA Zone 2 Stirrup Cup Finals only.

**Saturday Large Arena schooling:** If the Harrisburg Horse Show classes end before 7:00 pm there will be 2 hours of controlled schooling. If the show does not conclude by 7:00 pm then the arena will be closed at the conclusion of the last class and awards presentations.

**Sunday morning schooling:** There will be open rings from 5:00 am - 6:30 am for hacking only. The ring will not be open again throughout the day.

### Stabling

Stalls are temporary stalls in permanent buildings. Stalls are \$150 for Saturday night. All stalls must be vacant by 7:00 pm on Sunday, August 24, 2014.

### Accommodations

### General Information

All questions will be decided by show management whose decision shall be final. Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise. Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit entries and cancel award prizes without claims for damages; to cancel or combine unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience toward the judges or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry fee and other fees. Show management reserves to itself the power to prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any groom or horse from the show without being liable for compensation. All exhibitors must wear protective headgear at all times while mounted on the show grounds. All dogs must be on a leash and under owners control.
