- **Entries are due by August 24, 2016.** If we do not receive entry form and payment by August 24, we will notify the next qualified rider.
- No phone entries or post entries accepted.
- No refunds without a veterinarian note.
- Entry Fee: \$150/division except Medal class which is one class \$45 (does not include stabling).
- Requirement: Valid Coggins test for PA residents, Valid Coggins and Health Certificate for out-of-state residents must be presented before a back number will be issued.

Scratches

- Scratches are accepted before August 24, 2016.

Schooling and Arrival Rules

- Colonial Classic exhibitors may arrive 4:00 pm Friday, September 2, 2016.
- Schooling is not permitted Friday evening.
- Flatwork is permitted in the Equine arena on Saturday from 6:00 am - 6:45 am.
- There is no schooling permitted in the Large arena Saturday morning.
- Schooling is permitted in both arenas after the show on Saturday and before the show on Sunday. See schedule for exact schooling times and heights.
- Schooling is \$25.00 per session and will be collected at the gate.

Stabling

- Stalls are temporary stalls in permanent buildings.
- A weekend stall is \$150 and is available from 4:00 pm, Friday, September 2, 2016 and must be vacated by 9:00 pm on Sunday, September 2, 2016.
- Day stalls are not available this year.
- Reserve stalls and tack stalls fees can be found on the entry form.
- Shavings will be available to purchase at \$8/bale and must be reserved on entry form.

General Information

All questions will be decided by show management whose decision shall be final. Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise. Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit entries and cancel award prizes without claims for damages; to cancel or combine unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience toward the judges or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry fee and other fees. Show management reserves to itself the power to prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any groom or horse from the show without being liable for compensation. All exhibitors must wear protective headgear at all times while mounted on the show grounds. All dogs must be on a leash and under owners control.

I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. **Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver, and Indemnification: This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing:** I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition to the following: I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaulteur, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death. ("Harm"). I AGREE to hold harmless and release the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Competition. I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition. I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while at the Competition. I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the competition strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries. If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf. I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in this competition. I AGREE that if I am injured at this competition, the medical personnel treating my injuries may provide information on my injury and treatment to the competition accident/injury report form.
