### Entries

- Payment must be made on-line. Go to [www.colonialclassichorshow.com](http://www.colonialclassichorshow.com) for link.
- **Entries are due by Noon, August 21, 2020.** If we do not receive entry form and payment by August 21, we will notify the next qualified rider.
- No phone entries or post entries accepted.
- No refunds without a veterinarian note.
- Entry Fee: \$175/division except Medal class which is one class \$45 (does not include stabling). Blue/Red - \$35; Hunter Classic - \$50.
- **Required:** Valid Coggins test for PA residents. Valid Coggins, COVID Agreement and Health Certificate for out-of-state residents must be presented before a back number will be issued.

### Scratches

- Scratches are accepted until August 21, 2020.

### Stabling and Arrival Rules

- Horses may arrive beginning 8:00 AM, Thursday, August 27<sup>th</sup>.
- Hacking in the rings each morning, 5:30 AM – 6:15 AM.
- Schooling permitted in Equine and Large Arenas on Thursday, August 27<sup>th</sup> from approx.. 2:00 PM – 5:00 PM for \$20 per 10 minutes
- Flatwork is permitted in the Large Arena on Friday and Saturday mornings.
- There is NO schooling over the jumps.
- Blue-Red trips are available to all. The rider can be a trainer or another exhibitor that has signed an entry blank. Formal attire is not required. No more than one Blue-Red trip per entry per division. Each Blue-Red trip is \$35. Ribbons will be awarded. Junior riders only in Equine Arena.

### Stabling

- Stalls are both temporary stalls and permanent stalls in permanent buildings and tents.
- A weekend stall is \$150 and is available from 8:00 AM, Thursday, August 27; must be vacated by 9:00 pm on Sunday, August 30<sup>th</sup>.
- Day stalls are not available this year.
- Reserve stalls and tack stalls fees can be found on the entry form. Stabling form must accompany entry form.
- Shavings available for purchase at \$8/bale and must be reserved on entry form. No hay sales.

### General Information

All questions will be decided by show management whose decision shall be final. Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise. Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit entries and cancel award prizes without claims for damages; to cancel or combine unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience toward the judges or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry fee and other fees. Show management reserves to itself the power to prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any groom or horse from the show without being liable for compensation. All exhibitors must wear protective headgear at all times while mounted on the show grounds. All dogs must be on a leash and under owners' control.
